Sunday Reflection

- ✦ First Reading: Ezekiel 17:22-24
- ◆ Second Reading: 2 Corinthians 5:6-10
- ✦ Gospel: Mark 4:26-34

" A MAN THROWS SEED ON THE LAND. NIGHT AND DAY, WHILE HE SLEEPS, WHEN HE IS AWAKE, THE SEED IS SPROUTING AND GROWING, HOW! HE DOES NOT KNOW"; These readings to-day are about growth, not in the context of arable farming, but more so in the context of spiritual growth. Right now a few miles away Kew Botanical Gardens are bulging with so much natural beauty. All around us during these days of Summer, we see natural growth in bloom, we are enjoying this yearly newness of life; Mother Nature continues on with or without us; the 4 seasons express a natural beauty of their own; On our part we must never interfere in the workings of nature, or else suffer the consequences of a backlash from Mother Nature.
